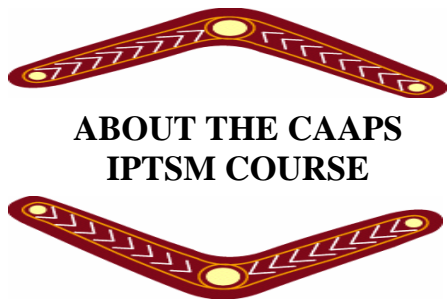

ABOUT THE CAAPS IPTSM COURSE

Course Outline

This course is targeted at Indigenous people in remote areas, school leavers, community health workers and other service providers new to the community services sector

The course was developed in consultation with a range of stakeholder groups including Indigenous peoples from remote areas. Tiwi islands, Milingimbi, Borroloola, Numbulwar, Groote Eylandt, Jabiru, Port Keats, Ramingining, Maningrida, Yirrkala, Warruwi and Minjilang.

Program Benefits

This unit aims to provide the participant with information to identify and describe the effects of alcohol and other drugs use on family and community, specifically as experienced by Aboriginal people.

This course is 20 hours contact and is presented both on campus at CAAPS and community based delivery.



Course Structure

This course covers the following competencies.

Unit Code UGO006

1. Identify behaviour and physiological responses associated with alcohol and other drug related use.
2. Identify how alcohol and other drug use affects Indigenous Communities and Culture.
3. Identify strategies for managing problems from the use of alcohol or other drugs.

Educators deliver the IPTSM Course in a culturally appropriate way.
